



Terms and Conditions

- 1) Applicants must be in full time education and between 15 and 25 years of age
- 2) Applicants will be required to make a declaration of good health and fitness
- 3) Membership with the Gliding Federation of Australia and the HVGC is mandatory. Initial 12 month membership fees are included in the scholarship.
- 4) Scholarships are available all year round, Total value of each scholarship is \$2,000 each
- 5) Each successful applicant will be issued with Basic Gliding Knowledge booklet and a log book. The cost of Basic Gliding Knowledge booklet and the log book are included in the scholarship.
- 6) The scholarship must be completed within 12 months from the date of initial membership.
- 7) An experienced flying instructor and mentor will be assigned to each successful candidate.
- 8) Successful candidates undertake to attend flying training as agreed with their mentor.
- 9) The HVGC operates on weekends and public holidays. The successful candidates must be available for the full day of training on any weekend as agreed with their mentor.
- 10) Inclement weather may prevent flying on any given day at the discretion of the duty instructor.
- 11) On each day of training the students will be required to assist with preparation, ground handling and retrieving of gliders as a critical component in the sport of gliding.
- 12) The HVGC may cancel the scholarship at the discretion of the Instructors panel and the HVGC committee.
- 13) The selection of successful candidates will be at the discretion of the HVGC President and the Chief Flying Instructor
- 14) The scholarship selection process will include:
 - This application
 - Aeronautical Experience Flight evaluation
 - Interview with the HVGC President or the Chief Flying Instructor
- 15) By signing the application you understand and agree to these terms and conditions

Warning

Gliding as with any flying activity can be DANGEROUS. Any person participating in the sport of gliding or learning to glide or participating in the activities of the Gliding Federation of Australia GFA does so entirely at their own risk.
